



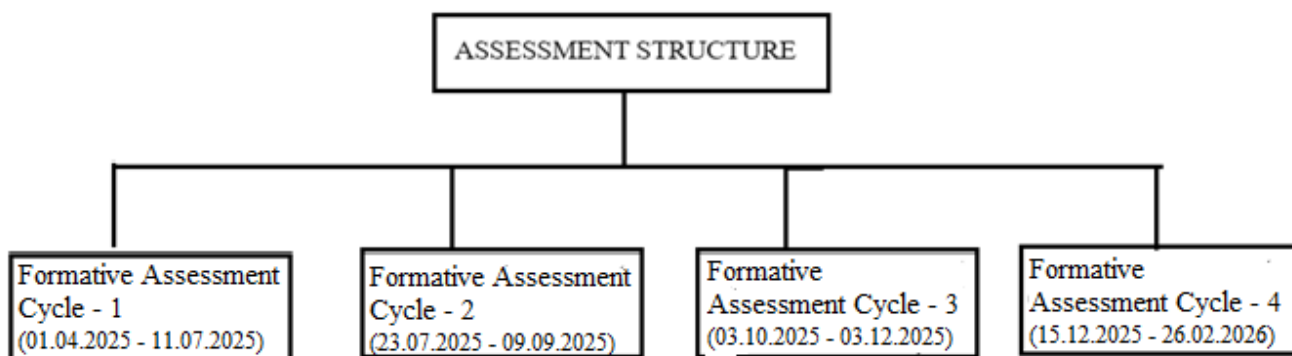

EXAM POLICY CLASS IX (2025 - 26)



SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT (Marks Distribution)

Periodic Test I - 50% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

Periodic Test II - 100% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

Periodic Test III - 50% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

Annual Examination - 100% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

** Examination of additional subject opted by any student will be taken in Periodic Test - II and Annual Examination.

Internal Assessment (20 marks)

One-time year-end examination is complemented and supplemented with Internal Assessment (IA) that assesses students in diverse manner, at different times and also examines a broad range of curriculum objectives. IA, in effect school-based assessment, plays the dual role of providing a complete picture of students' abilities or progress towards fulfilling the aims of education and informing teachers of students' progress and therefore supporting classroom learning. It also informs the individual learner about his/ her progress over a period of time enabling them to develop strategies to improve learning.

Each subject will include four types of activities: one Multiple Assessment, one Subject Enrichment, a Portfolio (assessed four times), and three Periodic Tests conducted during the academic session.

CRITERIA FOR PASSING CLASS IX

Minimum Passing Marks: To be declared **PASS** in Class IX examinations, students must **achieve 33% marks in the Annual Examination and 33% marks in Internal Assessment individually for all subjects (Main and Skill Subjects).**

ELIGIBILITY FOR RETEST/ DETENTION IN CLASS IX

1. A candidate who obtains less than 33% in at most two of the five main subjects will be required to retest in those subjects, regardless of their performance in the Skill (Vocational) subject.
2. A candidate securing less than 33% in any in three or more subjects will be placed in Essential Repeat Category.
