EXAM POLICY CLASS XI (2025 - 26)

ATTENDANCE: A student must have a minimum of **75% attendance** failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit for the final examination / will not be promoted to the next higher class, as per the CBSE guidelines.

SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT (Marks Distribution):

Formative Assessments (Class Test) - Tests conducted after each chapter. 20 Marks per test.

Periodic Test I - 50% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

Periodic Test II - 100% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

Periodic Test III - 50% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

Annual Examination - 100% of the total theory marks of that subject as per CBSE norms.

** Practical/Project - Will be conducted twice in the session. Best out of two practical examinations will be counted at the end of the session.

** Examination of additional subject opted by any student will be taken in Periodic Test II and Annual Examination.

Weightage of various assessments conducted in the entire session

NOTE: For 2 subjects, Marks Distribution will be as follows:

Commercial Art: 30 Marks Theory and 70 Marks Practical.

Artificial Intelligence: 50 Marks Theory and 50 Marks Practical.

CRITERIA FOR PASSING CLASS XI

Minimum Passing Marks: To be declared **PASS** in Class XI examinations, students **must achieve 33% marks in Theory in both Annual Examination and Overall yearly aggregate and 33% marks in Practical examinations individually for all subjects.**

Additional Subject: Students must pass in the chosen additional subject according to the criteria mentioned above.

For students who are unable to meet the pass criteria, a retest will be scheduled. Failure to fulfill the pass criteria after retest will lead to surrender of the additional subject in class XII.

ELIGIBILITY FOR RETEST/DETENTION IN CLASS XI


1. A candidate obtaining less than 33%, in one subject only, will qualify for a retest in that specific subject.
2. A candidate securing less than 33% in the retest shall be placed in the Essential Repeat Category.
3. A candidate obtaining less than 33% in two or more subjects will be placed in Essential Repeat Category.

For new admissions who have missed exams, the proportionate result will be calculated based on the exams attended.

ASSESSMENT OF CO-SCHOLASTIC AREAS

As per CBSE guidelines the co-scholastic areas in class XI are: General Studies, Work Experience and Health and Physical Education.

NOTE: Parents are encouraged to attend at least 80% of the PTMs conducted to ensure smooth communication and to address any issues promptly.
